Topical tip

Now that the leaves have fallen from soft fruit bushes, now is the time to do some pruning. It is also time to think about applying sulphate of potash around the base of both soft fruit and apple trees to help with fruit bud development. Apply 15 gram/square metre round the base of bushes and fruit trees any time from the beginning of January until the end of February.
