Last Club Meeting

We had a large turnout on the May Bank Holiday when Ray Broughton came to talk to us about Dianthus and Herbaceous Plants. As it was his two thousandth talk he started off with a few interesting odd facts.

- Milk, vinegar and salt are illegal for use in the garden.
- Groundsel and nasturtiums host up to 12 pests and diseases.
- Tomato sauce cleans secateurs and hedge trimmers; just leave on for 2 days, then rinse.
- Wipe pots with malt vinegar to keep vine weevils off.

The main difference between dianthus (carnations) and pinks is that pinks are hardy and dianthus are not. He showed us how to take cuttings and repot, and told us to remove any side flower buds, which will not open and take strength from the main bud.

We then saw pictures of good examples of herbaceous flowers, aster, scabious, astringia, oriental poppies, lupins and achillea, with anecdotes to go with them.
